CSR AS PER COMPANIES ACT 2013

According to section 135 of Companies Act 2013 every company having net worth of Rs.500 crore or more, or turnover of Rs. 1000 crore or more or net profit of Rs. 5 crore or more during any financial year shall constitute a corporate social responsibility committee of the board consisting of 3 or more directors, out of which at least one director shall be an independent director. This committee shall formulate and recommend to board, a CSR policy which shall indicate the activities to be under taken by company as specified in schedule VII. These companies should also contribute at least 2% of average net profit made

during 3 immediate preceding financial years on CSR activities. This rule came into force from 1st April 2014. Various companies like TATA, Reliance Industries Ltd.etc. are taking initiatives in relation to CSR.

MAIN FOCUS AREAS OF RELIANCE INDUSTRIES LTD IN REGARD TO CSR ARE:-

RURAL TRANSFORMATION:-

Reliance works towards bridging the developmental gap between rural 'Bharat' and urban India by improving rural livelihood, addressing poverty, malnutrition and hunger. The organization works to improve the productivity of farm lands, ensuring water security by water conservation and rain water harvesting. Reliance's information services provide important and timely information to farmers, fishers folk and livestock owners for taking right decisions to improve income and livelihood and also avert avoidable risks.

Activities of Reliance Industries in this regard in 2016-17

- Over 2200 ha of land was brought under improved cultivation.
- Water harvesting structures created to collect over cubic metres of rain water, securing 131 villages from drinking water perspective.
- Water harvesting and conservation efforts resulted in bringing over 2900 Ha land under irrigation.
- Livelihoods of more than 8 lakh farmers, fisher folks and livestock owners enhanced.

Reliance industries ltd. is taking various initiatives to bring improvement in awareness and healthy living practices in various part of India. The focus is on improving primary, secondary and tertiary healthcare facilities to enhance preventive and curative services. Through Drishti programme, the company has supported a number of visually impaired persons with corneal transplant surgeries.

Activities of Reliance Industries in this regard in 2016-17

- Over 5 lakh health consultants provided to patients through reliance managed hospitals, mobile and static units and various health camps.
- Over 33900 women were screened for anemia, of which 8,000 women were diagnosed and received treatment for it.
- The eye care services supported 1096 corneal transplants under Drishti programme.
- Over 400 HIV affected students were provided care and support along with nutrition supplementations.
- Over 29,700 children were screened for malnutrition and of these more than 2,000 children were found malnourished and followed up for treatment.

SPORTS FOR DEVELOPMENT

Reliance promotes health, an active lifestyle and fitness among youth through sports activities. Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched Reliance Foundation Youth Sports programme in July 2016. - 18 children were awarded scholarships under Youth Champ programme for developing football abilities.
- About 6 lakh students across 18 cities of India were encouraged to adopt healthy life style by integrating basketball into their physical education curriculum through the Reliance Foundation Jr.NBA programme.

DISASTER RESPONSE

Reliance has track record of organizing timely relief and rehabilitation of communities that are affected by natural calamities.

Activities of Reliance Industries in this regard in 2016-17

- It supported more than 100 drought affected villages across 4 districts of Maharashtra by providing more than 60 million litres of drinking water.
- Sona River in Aurangabad rejuvenated, ensuring drinking water security for more than 14000 people.
- Provided support to flood affected areas in Madhya Pradesh by providing timely information on disaster related compensations, disease management of crops to affected persons through technology enabled solutions.

After analyzing the total expenditure on CSR by Reliance Industries one can interpret that main areas which was considered by Reliance Industries for CSR spending are 1) Health 2) Educations 3) Rural transformation. It can be seen that reliance has focused mainly on health area. In the year 2011- 12 and 2012-13 annual CSR spending is less than 2% of PAT but after 2013 when 2% of average profit made immediate preceding three years CSR spending is made compulsory by law spending on CSR increased to double. Sports were not to be important factor in year 2011-12 and 2012-13, but after 2013 Reliance started focusing on sports development.

CONCLUSION

In present era, CSR is considered to be a vital aspect for growth and goodwill of the company. Before the imposition of law spending done under CSR was purely out of will, it was not compulsory by ministry of corporate affairs. The companies should contribute toward society and environment because they use the resources from society to generate profits. It has great impact on their goodwill or reputation. Reliance has done various efforts toward various areas but its main priority areas are health, education and rural transformation. It is expected that in future Reliance industries ltd. will maintain its CSR standard and help in sustainable development of country.
