Dictionary of 50,000 words published in 1988 by the Chief Publishing House of the Uzbek Economic Community (UzSE) did not include such concepts as "value", "national consciousness", "national revival" and "national pride".

So, how do you comment on that?

If there are currently 262 countries in the world, about 200 of them are on the path to democratic development. It is recognized by the world society that democracy has been established in these states as a national and universal value. It is by the present time that the recognition of democracy by the world community as the most acceptable form of development of the way of life of mankind provides for the study of democracy as a national and universal value.

Therefore, the role of national and universal values in the development of democracy and the construction of a civil state is invaluable. Since Uzbekistan gained independence, the achievement of great success in the moral and spiritual sphere in a short period of history has been

Muhammad Bobur's work "Boburnoma" reflects many spiritual and educational qualities inherent to Uzbeks. These are spiritual traits such as faith and conviction, prudence, love for family, honesty, ambition, love of children for parents, brothers, sisters, relatives, absence of abuse of other people's good, observance of religious values, literacy, generosity, kindness, courage, justice, humanity, shyness, hard work. and straightforwardness.

The current national spirituality and values of the people of Uzbekistan are the continuation of the national spirituality of the past, which includes such spiritual and moral qualities as friendliness, hospitality, humanity, humanism, spiritual clarity, entrepreneurship, generosity, politeness and cleanliness, shyness, courage, devotion to the Motherland and the people, sincerity, love for one's family, honesty, truthfulness, piety, consistency, tolerance, balance, respect for parents and elders,

Abdullah Avloniy and other scholars of enlightenment in the late XIX and early XX centuries sadly wrote that it is possible to get rid of the spiritual decline of the reigning in Turkestan only by strengthening the educational work and increasing the spirituality of the people. their lives. That is what he said: "The people's aspiration to a certain goal, their wealth, happiness and respect, the fact that they will be conquerors or the weak and poor, will carry the burden of misfortune, will be left unattended, and will be a slave to strangers and will obey them, depending on the education they received from their parents as children".
